## THE DOUBLE MAJOR APPLICATION IS A CONTRACT

This application, including the program plan you submit, is a contract between yourself, the major departments, and the College. Changes to your program plan must be approved by your major and College advisers.

## REVIEW & NOTIFICATION PROCESS

Your application will be reviewed and retained by the Office of Undergraduate Advising. One month after you apply, use BearFacts to confirm your double major approval. If there is a problem with your program, you will be notified by the College.
